INSTRUCTION FOR USE

The surface has to be leveled, dry and clean. The wet coverage of the adhesive is $3-4~\text{m}^2/\text{kg}$ subject to porosity of the substrate, film thickness and nature of material being bonded. Apply the adhesive uniformly on the substrate using suitable equipment. Allow the adhesive to set for approx. 15 to 20 minutes to become tacky then lay the floor covering. It is essential to ensure good contact between the floor covering and adhesive.

STORAGE & HANDLING

CASBond FA 50 should be stored inside warehouse in the original, unopened and undamaged containers in a dry place between 5 - 25°C.

It must be protected from frost and sunlight during storage.
